Basic Programming for All PRC Devices – 3 hour

This product training focuses on basic programming and operations of any PRC device (Accent[®] 800/ 1000/1400, PRiO[®] or legacy devices). The class will start out with an overview of language systems. Then participants will learn how to: choose a vocabulary, change the voice, set the access method, add vocabulary and messages, add photos, temporarily limit vocabulary, disable the toolbox and perform a memory transfer to back up device contents. In addition, participants will learn about basic care, maintenance, resources and support.

Devices for this training are required. Please see website for details.

This training is appropriate for SLPs, OTs, ATPs, educators, family members, and others who support individuals who currently use or may need to use PRC devices.

LEARNING OUTCOMES - Participants will be able to:

- set a vocabulary, voice, and access method for an individual

- perform a memory transfer to back up device contents as well as disable the toolbox
