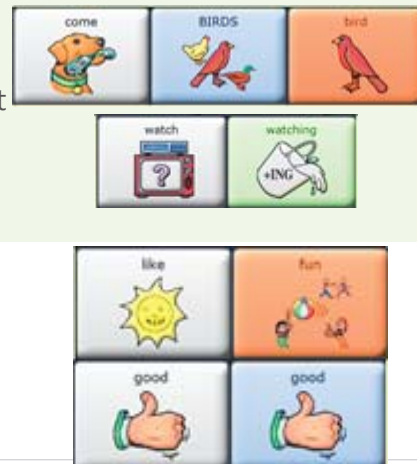
## LAMP Words For Life 84 Full

### Core Word Activity of the Month

Begin the New Year with a new hobby! Make an easy peanut butter pine cone bird feeder and enjoy bird watching.

- Tie string around a pine cone and spread ½ cup of peanut butter over it
- Roll the peanut butter covered pine cone in birdseeds on a paper plate until it is covered. Hang it near a window and watch for birds.
- Teach the -ing verb ending by modeling the word “watching”
- Teach the -s plural to talk about more than one bird
- Alternative: Look for videos on YouTube and talk about birds
- As the communication partner, whether you are a family member, teacher/therapist or friend, use these words as you talk to model where they are located and how powerful they can be. Try using these words to model language as you make this project and watch for birds this month!
